

How does the academy evaluate its SEND provision?

At St Anthony's Girls' Catholic Academy we monitor and evaluate the effectiveness of provision for SEND students in the following ways:

- Classroom observations as part of our Quality Assurance processes
- Learning walks by Senior Leadership Team (SLT)
- Ongoing assessment of progress made by intervention groups
- Observation of interventions
- Work sampling
- Student progress tracking using assessment data (whole-academy processes)
- Informal feedback from all staff
- Student interviews when setting new targets or reviewing existing targets
- Student Voice forum
- SEND parents open evenings to capture parent voice
- Parent and Student online surveys
- Monitoring SEN support plan targets, evaluating the impact on students' progress
- Attendance records and liaison with the Attendance Officer
- Regular meetings about students' progress with SLT, Pastoral leaders and Curriculum leaders
- Termly feedback from students and parents during review meetings
