

What happens if my child has a high level of need?

The SENDCo will be heavily involved in planning SEN support and any transition required for your child. Your child will be monitored on a daily basis, their plans will be reviewed regularly and support adjusted as required. Advice will be sought from other professionals who work with the child. Our SENDCo will link with other medical professionals to create a SEN support plan personally tailored to your child.

Staff will be kept informed about any adjustments that need to take place in the classroom, and additional testing will be carried out and intervention put in place if required.

Your child may be entitled to special arrangements in exams. This could include support with reading or receiving extra time to complete the exams.
