Hints and Tips:

- Break your revision down in small bitesize geography chunks
- Make sure your notes/books are organised and easy to follow
- Carry out extra reading and research. The more case study examples the better
- Make revision cards on the main concepts
- Look at how many marks the question is worth to give you an indication of how much detail you need to go into
- Highlight the command word in the question (bug the question)
- Use a glossary of all the key words that can be included in longer answer questions
- Most importantly start your revision early and don't leave it to the last minute
