About Us

St. Anthony's Girls' Catholic Academy welcomes students aged 11-18 years, of all faiths and beliefs. We are an Ofsted rated Good school with over 1,300 students on roll.

School was originally founded by the Sisters of Mercy in 1904, based on a core ethos:

- Christ centred education
- Faith enlightened education
- Concern for the poor and the education of women and girls
- Building communities
- Pursuing excellence

We are situated in the centre of Sunderland within walking distance of train, metro and bus stations. Our site consists of two historic listed buildings and a state of the art modern building which provides light and airy classroom facilities, ICT suites and sporting facilities. The school and Sixth Form moved to its current site during the Second World War (1939). In 2017 our school joined St. Aidan's Catholic Boys' Academy in establishing a shared Sixth Form and we now offer shared provision to over 350 female and male students in Years 12 and 13.

We're very proud of our World Class Schools Quality Mark. This is awarded by education charity World Class Schools Quality Mark, whose unique assessment framework assesses the students, not the school, for their demonstration of World Class skills and competencies. The premise is that if the school is truly World Class, then its students should be able to demonstrate this in whatever context they find themselves. To date there are just 140 accredited World Class schools in the UK, all non-selective state schools.



Our Trust

We are proud to be part of Bishop Chadwick Catholic Education Trust.

We are a catholic multi-academy Trust and currently have thirty schools, five secondary schools (four with sixth forms), and twenty five primary schools (14 have nursery provision). The Trust covers the east part of the Diocese of Hexham and Newcastle, we have schools in East Durham, South Tyneside and Sunderland.

Pastoral support & Enrichment

Special Educational Needs and Disabilities (SEND)

We provide Individual Education Programmes, co-ordinated by our SEND Coordinator for students with SEND. We work with students, parents and carers alongside external agencies to provide appropriate, tailored support so that students make exceptional progress.

Personal Development

In addition to our taught curriculum, we offer a wide range of enrichment, character development and student leadership activities for students to get involved with at St. Anthony's.

The music department offers many activities such as choirs and orchestras and an annual musical theatre production. We also offer Bronze, Silver and Gold Arts Award to all students. We regularly attend national and local competitions and offer a music tour to a European city. We offer instrumental and vocal lessons which can lead to qualifications.

Our dedicated PE team run a variety of lunchtime and after school clubs including athletics, dance, football, rounders, tennis and trampolining. This gives students the opportunity to reach very high standards and compete for their city, county, on a regional and national level. They also organise a range of cultural, educational and sporting visits both in the UK and overseas, for example visits to Derwent Hill, Wimbledon and water sports centres in France.

Students have the opportunity to take part in the Duke of Edinburgh Award and Pope John Paul II Award, and St Anthony's has Green Flag status as an Eco-School and International School Status.

We run an extensive careers programme with work experience opportunities and external speakers to raise aspirations.







Chadwick's Kitchen

Our award winning in-house catering team Chadwick's Kitchen, provide catering services across the Trust. We use fresh ingredients to prepare healthy and nutritionally balanced meals each day. The majority of our menus are homemade by our chefs in our kitchens.

Staff are trained to accommodate medical diets and work in partnership with parents to ensure these needs are met. As part of the Trust's commitment to sustainability, we regularly review food miles and continue to work to reduce food waste.

Parents/Carers can pay for school meals using ParentPay, and can view meal choices and account balance online. This operates via a biometric (finger scanning) process, improving efficiency and removing the need for cash. Students entitled to free meals are allowed to purchase food to the value of a free school meal allowance daily.

What makes St. Aidan's & St. Anthony's Sixth Form so special is our many years of experience. The quality of teaching, the level of pastoral encouragement, support and guidance and the strength of our Catholic ethos. Also our students have their own designated facilities which allow them to thrive. Year 12 students are situated at Gabriel House and Year 13 students at the Briery.

Our Sixth Form has an excellent reputation for high quality post-16 provision. For the last decade 85-90% of students have progressed to University with a third of students accessing the most prestigious universities.
